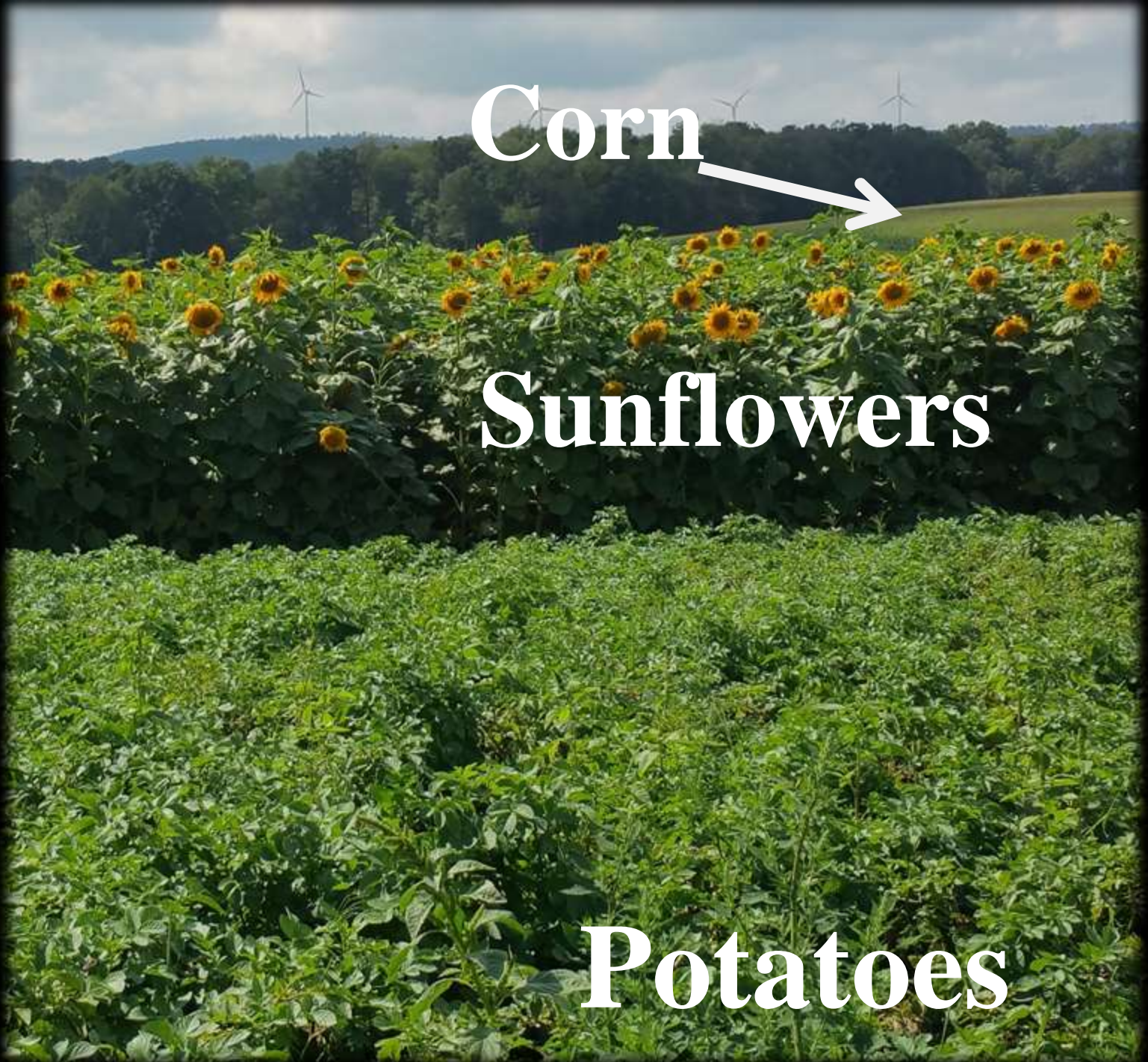

Vs 16

“Praise your Father”

Praise:

glorify–honor–to render excellent

Whose actions are highlighted?

Matthew 5

Vs 1-2

Now when He (Jesus) saw the crowds, He went up on a mountainside and sat down. His disciples came to Him, and He began to teach them, saying:

Vs 3

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

➤ Those who are engaged in the kingdom of heaven supply

Vs 4

Blessed are those who mourn, for
they will be comforted.

Comforted:

To call to one's side

To receive relief and strength

➤ Those who are being freed
from life dampening sin

Vs 5

Blessed are the meek, for they
will inherit the earth.

Inherit:

to take control of - have power over

An increased influence over the land
is a byproduct of meekness

1 Corinthians 3:21-23

So then, no more boasting about men!

All things are yours, whether Paul or
Apollos or Cephas or the world or life
or death or the present or the future--
all are yours, and you are of Christ, and
Christ is of God.

➤ Those who are moving
mountains

Vs 6

Blessed are those who hunger and
thirst for righteousness, for they will
be filled.

➤ Those who are filled with
righteousness

Vs 7

Blessed are the merciful, for they
will be shown mercy.

Merciful:

A distressed heart for the hurt of
others

Not satisfied with standing idle
while another suffers

➤ Those who are receiving mercy

Vs 8

Blessed are the pure in heart, for
they will see God.

➤ Those who are seeing God

Vs 9

Blessed are the peacemakers, for
they will be called sons of God.

➤ Those who are called the sons/daughters of God
